## VINEYARD

Planted in 2009 at 1,600 feet elevation on Mission Peak, above the San Francisco Bay's fog line, the cooler climate provides a beautiful terrain for this Cabernet Sauvignon to grow to its full potential. Nestled in a picturesque rolling hill landscape, only half an acre of the single clone, 191, graces the furthest western slope. Natural springs quench the entirety of the vineyard, ensuring its vitality. Each grape is carefully handpicked, reflecting a commitment to quality and craftsmanship.
