



2019 PINOT NOIR RESERVE

VINEYARD

Planted in 2009 at 1,600 feet elevation on Mission Peak, sitting above the San Francisco Bay's fog line, the cooler climate provides unique aromas and complex flavors to this Pinot Noir. Clones include VCR18, 777, 667, 115 and the famous Swan. Depending on the clone, this varietal faces both Northern and the Western sun. The entire vineyard is quenched by natural springs. All grapes are hand picked.

TASTING NOTES

Color: Translucent ruby red

Aroma: Bright array of fresh summer berries and earthy tones

Palate: Ripe strawberries, cranberries, and pomegranates, accented by subtle notes of rose petals and forest floor. It's supple texture, framed by gentle tannins and bright acidity, offers a harmonious balance, leading to a finish with delicate spice undertones and a lingering impression of elegance and finesse.
