



2019 PINOT NOIR

VINEYARD

Planted in 2009 at 1,600 feet elevation on Mission Peak, rooted above the San Francisco Bay's fog line, the cooler climate provides unique aromas and complex flavors to this Pinot Noir. Clones include VCR18, 777, 667, and 115. Depending on the clone, this varietal faces both Northern and the Western sun. The entire vineyard is quenched by natural springs. All grapes are hand picked.

Color: Translucent ruby red

Aroma: Bright red cherry, freshly picked raspberry, vanilla

Palate: A delicate yet complex palate featuring red fruit flavors, complemented by subtle earthy undertones and hints of spice with moderate acidity, supple tannins, and a silky texture
