



2021 PINOT NOIR RESERVE

VINEYARD

Planted in 2009 at 1,600 feet elevation on Mission Peak, positioned above the San Francisco Bay's fog line, the cooler climate provides unique aromas and complex flavors to this Pinot Noir. Clones include VCR18, 777, 667, 115 and the famous Swan that add's a well balanced body. Depending on the clone, this varietal faces both Northern and the Western sun. Natural springs quench the entirety of the vineyard, ensuring its vitality. Each grape is carefully handpicked, reflecting a commitment to quality and craftsmanship.

TASTING NOTES

Color: Translucent ruby red

Aroma: Vibrant cherry, dried herbs, and vanilla

Palate: A rich array of flavors hitting the mid palate, including vibrant red fruits like cherry and raspberry layered with nuances of black tea, truffle, and dried herbs. Its refined texture, supported by velvety tannins and balanced acidity, leads to a lingering finish marked by hints of vanilla and oak, contributing to its complexity and depth.
