



2021 ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR

VINEYARD

Planted in 2009 at 1,600 feet elevation on Mission Peak, sitting above the San Francisco Bay's fog line, the cooler climate provides unique aromas and complex flavors to the Pinot Noir grape which were used for this Rosé. Clones VCR18 and 777 in the vineyard are northern facing on a slight downward slope with minimal elevation change. The entire vineyard is quenched by natural springs. All grapes are hand picked.

APPELLATION - San Francisco Bay

FRUIT SOURCE - Mission Peak Vineyards, Fremont CA

TASTING NOTES

Color: Pale delicate pink

Aroma: Ripe strawberry, warm melon, and honeydew

Palate: The palate begins with beautiful ripe fruit and sweet floral expression echoing the nose with sweet strawberry and watermelon. The wine has a refreshing acidity and is completely dry. The rosé is elegant yet playful on the palate as it concludes with a dry and pleasing hint of honeydew on the finish.
